

WEST FORK HIGH SCHOOL 2010 - 2011 SUPPLY LIST

ART SUPPLIES

Art I: Spiral-bound drawing pad, #2 pencils in abundance, eraser, white school glue, scissors, ruler, protractor, colored pencils, set of paint brushes (not cheap, but not expensive), extra-fine black marker (permanent), 1 box Kleenex, supply box to keep everything in. These supplies should last a student all 4 years.

Painting 1 & 2: Nice set of paint brushes (well kept ones from previous years will work), paint shirt, pencils, colored pencils, spiral-bound drawing pad and folder.

Drawing 1 & 2: Set of drawing pencils, pencil sharpener, colored pencils, eraser, folder and spiral-bound drawing pad.

Art Metals 1 & 2: Folder, spiral bound drawing pad or notebook, hair ties for long hair, safety glasses and occasional minor expenses for stones, etc.

Graphic Communications: Spiral-bound drawing pad, folder, set of black markers ranging from ultra-fine to fine tip, set of multi-color Sharpie markers (fine & extra-fine) crayons, colored pencils, set of drawing pencils, eraser and a supply box to keep all the supplies in.

Pottery: Apron or old shirt or coveralls to keep clothes clean (or wear old clothes on pottery day), drawing pad or notebook and a folder.

If you are taking more than one art class you can use your drawing pad for multiple classes.

ENGLISH 9-12 SUPPLIES

Book cover, folder, blue or black pens, 3-ring binder, perforated notebooks, highlighters of various colors

FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCE SUPPLIES

FCS I: The class will be constructing quillos. Each student needs: 2 ½ yards each of 2 fabrics, at least 45 inches wide, woven cloth with no stretch, matching thread, batting for quillos will be purchased in bulk to save money for students. The class will also knit or crochet pot holders and create a design on ceramic plate. To defray the cost of these projects, the students are asked to bring \$12.00. Checks to be made out to SCMT School.

Textile Designs: Rotary cutter. Material will be purchased during class time. Students will construct a queen size quilt.

Culinary Arts: \$10.00 lab fee.

Child Development: 10 pound bag of sugar.

HEALTH SUPPLIES: Notebook, folder, pencils, pen (blue or black).

CHOIR SUPPLIES: Ladies: Black, closed toe, low heeled dress shoes. Men: Black dress pants, black socks, and black dress shoes.

MATH SUPPLIES

All math classes need paper, pencils, eraser, and notebook.

Geometry & Basic Geometry: Scientific calculator (needs to have trig functions, graphing not necessary).

Pre-Calc: Graphing calculator

Algebra I & Algebra II: Scientific calculator

Trig & Stats: TI83 or TI84 calculator

SOCIAL STUDIES SUPPLIES: 2 notebooks, folder, and pens.

SCIENCE SUPPLIES

Students are required to wear closed-toe shoes in all science classrooms. NO SANDALS ALLOWED.

Paper, #2 or mechanical pencils, pens (blue or black, no red).

Biology: Book cover, white t-shirt for tie-dye lab, craft items for cell (more descriptive list later), notebook.

Environmental Science: Book cover, notebook.

Earth Science: Book cover, craft items to make 3D geological time scale model, notebook

Anatomy: Book cover, colored pencils, craft items for cell (more descriptive list later), notebook

Physical Science: At least 1 composition book (blank bound books, 9 ¾ x 7 ½ inches, cover is usually black and white pattern). Students will do several projects throughout the school year. Supplies for these projects will be explained as project is assigned.

Chemistry, Advanced Chemistry & Physics: At least 1 composition book (blank bound books, 9 ¾ x 7 ½ inches, cover usually a black and white pattern, scientific calculator (Texas Instruments recommended, and a graphing calculator is recommended), note cards, colored pencils, graph paper. Supplies for projects throughout the year will be explained when the projects are assigned.
