4. A record of successful completion of the driver's education course will be acknowledged by the school, but the completion of this course does not apply toward the graduation requirements.

A student given one credit for every class they take and successfully complete each semester. For example: If a student is taking eight classes and passes all of them he will get eight credits for the semester. Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors are required to take eight classes per semester. Seniors must take six classes per semester.
